Deciduous Forest — Vegitation

Range of temperature and precipitation.

Two types of Tundra:

1- Arctic

 Polar climate, far from equator, "deep layer of permanently frozen ground called permafrost," fewer than 18 inches of soil thaws during summer

2- Alpine

- Tops of mountains above timberline, different elevations, more rain than arctic and more sunlight.
